# Appliance Test Loss of electrics

### Tools

- Torch

### Steps

1. Go around the property and unplug EVERYTHING from the wall sockets. **(make sure the socket is switched off too)**
2. Go to the fuse box and put all the fuses down.
3. Might be good to get something to see in the dark first!
4. Put up the fuses in this order:
5. Main fuse (Big red one)
6. RCD/Ring Main
7. All the rest, one by one.
8. If fuses do go back up, plug each appliance in one by one to see if the electric stays on or to determine what appliance maybe faulty.
9. If the fuses will not go back up and everything has been unplugged an emergency order would need to be raised for an electrician to attend
