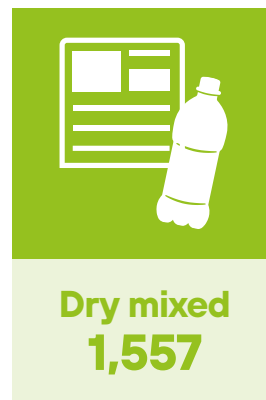
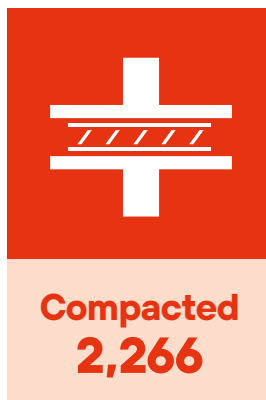
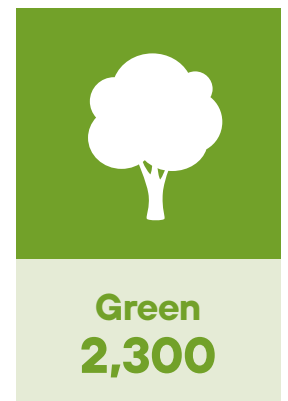
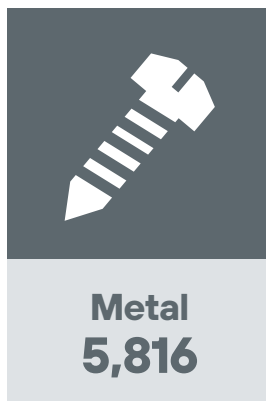


Mears Group waste statistics 2015-2019

Fines and non-compliance

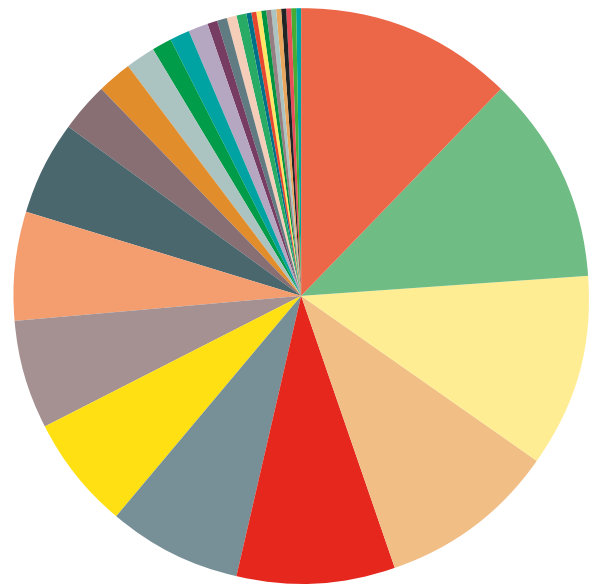
Mears Group has never received a fine or prosecution relating to any incidents of fly-tipping or the mismanagement of waste.
